

1		Boat Quay (2024)  In favour of a fluid and gestural approach, Ang's expressive brush strokes imbue the scene with a sense of energy and immediacy. The interplay of blue, purple and white with splashes of colour, transforms a familiar landscape into a heightened realm of symbolism that transcends faithful representation. Remaining rooted in the recognisable silhouette of Boat Quay, the iconic godowns and tugboats exude a historic charm reflecting Singapore River's past as a centre of trade and port of call. 
## Pink House-Chinatown (2023)
